



- Mow lawn to 2 3½ inches
- Leave grass clippings on the lawn
- Mow with sharp blades for a clean cut



- Cut more than ¹/₃ of the grass blade height
- Mow with debris on your lawn
- Mow when the grass is wet

weeding »


Weeds can dominate lawns, taking nutrients from grasses and other plants. Work with a professional to apply pre-emergent and post-emergent fertilizers to prevent weed growth.



seeding or sodding »

Seeding establishes new grass while laying sod adds mature grass. Water regularly and fertilize to ensure the grass continues to grow.

container gardens

Add flowers and greenery or fruits and vegetables to unique pots for the perfect container garden.

low maintenance plants

ultimate SEASONAL CHECKLIST

Work with a local professional to complete these seasonal tasks

Spring

- Test your soil
- Fertilize your lawn, trees and shrubs
- Control weeds before they invade
- Apply an inch-thick layer of mulch to garden beds and trees
- Inspect your irrigation system





- Aerate your lawn to improve oxygen flow
- Remove any weeds
- Mow your grass regularly
- Water your plants and grass for healthy growth
- Seed and sod early to promote new growth

Summer

Fall

- Seed and fertilize to promote future growth
- Keep your grass at 2 2½ inches tall
- Give trees and shrubs a final deep watering
- Prune plants
- Shut off water lines to prevent freezing





- Rake leaves and remove debris
- Aerate and fertilize lawn
- Apply mulch to protect trees, plants and shrubs
- Prune plants
- Take precautions against wind and cold by wrapping fragile plants in burlap


backyard PARTY CENTRAL

WATER


- Fountains and ponds create a luxurious and soothing environment
